Directions

For longest lasting durability, print on cardstock. Cut out along the black lines.

Select about 10–15 words per game. Make sure each selected word has a matching card in the playing deck. Shuffle the cards and pass out four cards to each player. Put the rest of the cards in the center of the table facing downward. Player I will begin by asking any other player if he or she has a word that matches a word in Player I's hand. For example, Player I may ask: "John, do you have the word mat?" If that player has a match, he or she would give player I the matching card. If that player does not have a match, the player will say "Go Fish" and Player I will draw a new card from the deck. Take turns moving clockwise until all matches have been made. The player with the most cards at the end wins.
