Summer Reading Activities

Water Words

Materials Needed: Water gun, IMSE Summer Review Document, Water source (e.g., a bucket of water or hose)

Directions: Choose a suitable outdoor area for the activity, such as a backyard or a park. Fill the Super Soaker water gun with water. Find a surface such as pavement or a brick wall to write on with water. Start by selecting a word from the review document. Call out the word to your child, ensuring they hear it clearly. Encourage them to repeat the word after you. After your child has repeated the word, they will use the Super Soaker water gun to spell it out.

Materials Needed: Marker, Index Cards, IMSE Summer Review Document


Directions: Select 6 words from the IMSE Summer Review Document. Create playing cards using Index cards and write selected words on cards. Each card should have a matching card, so you will create 12 cards total. With two players, begin by selecting 3 cards each. Player I asks Player 2 if he/she has the a word on a card of his/her choice. If Player 2 has the requested card, he/she must give the card to Player I. In this case, Player I gets another turn. If Player 2 does not have the requested card, Player 2 says, Go Fish and Player I should draw a card. Repeat until all matches are made. Whoever has the most matches winsl



Word Hunt

Materials Needed: Marker, Index Cards, IMSE Summer Review Document

Directions: Write words from IMSE Summer Review Document on flashcards. Hide the flashcards in an outdoor area. Set a timer for a specified duration. Children find and read as many words as possible before the timer ends. Count and celebrate the number of words read.



Sound Hopping

Materials Needed: Hula Hoops, Sidewalk Chalk

Directions: Select words from IMSE Summer Review Document and create a list. Call the words out to your child clearly. Set up hula hoops in a line. Have your child repeat each word, then hop into new hoop each time they say a sound in the word. Then, give them chalk and let him or her spell the word on blacktop or pavement.
