IMSE educates and engages teachers on Structured Literacy, enabling them to immediately impact students' reading abilities at all levels through programs based on the Science of Reading and incorporating the Orton-Gillingham methodology and all five pillars of literacy. These components include:

- **Phonological Awareness** – the awareness that words are composed of sounds and those sounds have distinct articulatory features
- **Phonics** – the ability to recognize letter-sound relationships in words
- **Fluency** – the ability to read with speed, accuracy, and proper expression
- **Vocabulary** – size and word-meaning strategies predict comprehension
- **Comprehension** – understanding the meaning of text and integrating it with previous knowledge

IMSE's IDA-accredited programs deliver measurable growth for all students, enabling equity in literacy learning. All IMSE trainers have a minimum of a master's degree in an education field of study, have taught Orton-Gillingham and other Structured Literacy programs in the classroom, are CERI certified and are licensed educators.

In addition to individual, school-wide, and district-wide teacher training, the IMSE team can educate district trainers to become certified IMSE instructors, empowered to bring Structured Literacy to the entire district. By making literacy education about imparting knowledge, not just teaching content, IMSE's impact is felt beyond reading growth to create a culture of literacy.

IMSE COMPREHENSIVE ORTON-GILLINGHAM TRAINING

IMSE's Comprehensive Orton-Gillingham Training is a 30-hour course geared towards the foundational literacy skills that all early learners need and primarily focuses on:

- Phonological Awareness
- Phonics
- Encoding/Decoding

More than learning about Structured Literacy and the Science of Reading, teachers will be equipped with the tools and knowledge to bring what they've learned back into the classroom.

Participants in this training will learn to administer IMSE informal criterion-referenced assessments and phonological awareness assessments for differentiation and ongoing progress monitoring. Participants will learn multisensory strategies for:

- Reading
- Writing
- Spelling regular and irregular words
- Fluency
- Vocabulary
- Comprehension

Participants will also master teaching seven-syllable types and four-syllable patterns for encoding/decoding. IMSE will provide participants with practical strategies needed to teach students at varying levels of reading competency and are supported with guidelines for weekly lesson plans they can implement on day one.

IMSE INTERMEDIATE TRAINING

The IMSE Intermediate Training is a 30-hour course designed for upper elementary educators with a solid understanding of phonology. Participants in this course will learn how to teach:

- Advanced spelling rules
- Encoding and decoding with seven-syllable types
- Vocabulary

This course also gives an in-depth study of orthography, the conventional spelling system of a language, and morphology, the study of the forms of words.

Participants in the IMSE Intermediate Training will learn vocabulary with morphology- affixes and Latin and Greek bases, as well as encoding/decoding strategies that are effective for older students. IMSE will provide participants with the tools needed to teach students at varying levels of reading competency and are supported with guidelines for weekly lesson plans they can implement on day one.

IMSE PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS (PA) TRAINING

The IMSE Phonological Awareness is a 2-day, 12.5-hour course that provides educators with a deeper understanding of phonological awareness and its importance in learning to read. After this training, educators will better understand assessing and teaching phonological awareness to students of all ages in all three tiers of Response to Intervention (RTI).

Participants in the PA Training will learn the importance of phonological awareness and how to assess students in phonemic awareness and implement one-minute phonemic awareness activities. Participants will learn the correct production of the 44 sounds of the English language and how to incorporate multisensory strategies in classroom activities. IMSE will provide participants with the tools needed to teach students at varying levels of reading competency.
